

Dress Code

Members should be aware that standards of dress are required at the Club. To prevent embarrassment, please ensure your compliance as Members or Guests who are not appropriately attired will be REFUSED ENTRY to the Club.

Members' Dining Room;

Jacket and Tie

Verandah and all other public areas of the Clubhouse;

Smart contemporary – To avoid any ambiguity 'smart casual' **DOES NOT** include Jeans, denim of ANY colour, cargo pants or tracksuits, polo shirts, collarless shirts, apparel with any advertising messages or slogans. Running shoes, sandals or athletic footwear of any kind **are not permitted**.

Terrace Café, Terrace Garden, 40 Below and North Terrace

The dress code for the above areas is contemporary and relaxed.

- Tailored shorts are permitted —cargo shorts are NOT permitted
- Jeans are permitted no rips or tears
- Casual sandals and enclosed shoes are permitted no thongs or joggers
- Collared T-shirts are permitted T-shirts without collars are NOT permitted
- Ladies are permitted to wear tailored shorts, pants or skirts
- No workout, gym or beach wear including joggers will be permitted

If Members wish to use the Terrace Garden, Terrace Café, 40 Below or North Terrace facilities and are arriving or departing through the front entrance of the Club, they will be escorted directly to the stairs to proceed to these areas.

It is expected that Members will exercise discretion to ensure that they and their Guests are suitably attired and in keeping with good taste and the proper decorum of the Club.

Please note: Members and their guests will not be able to access other traditional areas of the Club if not suitably attired

Club Function and Events;

Each event will specify a dress code and Members are asked to adhere to this.

Accommodation;

Tolerance is extended in relation to dress when Members or Guests are arriving or departing directly from our accommodation rooms. As an overriding principal, it is expected that Members will exercise discretion to ensure that they and their Guests are attired and in keeping with good taste and the proper decorum of the Club.
